Available Scholarships

Kenneth W. Hoefs Renewable Scholarships

Four \$2000 Scholarships meeting the following criteria:

- 1. Graduate from Hankinson High School with a GPA of at least 3.0 based on a 4.0 scale.
- 2. Has plans to attend a university or college located in **North Dakota** at time of application. Be properly admitted to a university or college located in **North Dakota** at the time of disbursement of the scholarship.
- 3. Scholarship recipients must be enrolled to carry the equivalent credit load of a full-time student and be pursuing an academic major.
- 4. The scholarship can be renewed for subsequent three years (for a total of 4) provided that the student maintains at least a GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale and continues to meet criteria #2 and #3.

Additional Hankinson Education Foundation Scholarships are available.

All Scholarship Recipients must graduate from Hankinson High School, enroll as a full-time student in an accredited institution of post-secondary education, and be a US citizen.

The Hankinson Education Foundation reserves the right to consider only applications found to be complete as of the application deadline. Include a copy of your most recent High School transcript that includes the current cumulative GPA. Finalists will be invited to interview with the Hankinson Education Foundation Board of Directors for final award determination. Interviews will be scheduled later.
